Ol Seki name is derived from the sandpaper tree - Cordia monoica which is also a symbol of peace. Set on large, dramatic rocks, overlooking the seasonal Isupukiai River, Ol Seki Mara Camp enjoys panoramic views in a gorgeous wilderness setting teeming with game. Located in Eastern Koiyaki, north of the Masai Mara game reserve, Ol Seki provides a rare opportunity to enjoy wildlife viewing in a pristine setting.
