

Naboisho Camp is situated in the Naboisho Conservancy (a 50,000 acre area) that lies to the far east of the Mara/Serengeti Eco system. The camp is in close proximity to vast open plains which are untraversed by other camps and tourists, your game viewing here will be exceptional, as well as completely exclusive. Night drives and walking is also a highlight.

The management is backed by a team of professional Masai safari guides and camp crew that have worked together for many years. Together they provide our guests with an in depth and truly memorable Masai Mara experience that remains true to its setting. The camp is now hosted and managed by Dudu and Jono (previous camp managers at Rekero).

Every year the camp is broken and removed for two months to allow the bush and the many wildlife neighbours to return to the site leaving a fresh and recovered wilderness for the next season. www.crocodileracers.com
