Guest suite facilities include king size double beds and singles, all with en-suite bathrooms with flush toilets and showers, sinks mirror and sufficient lighting. The tents have hot and cold showers throughout the day as water is harvested from well source and pumped to safe storage tanks; generator for lighting and charging your cameras or cell phones is available and for free.
