

Olkeri Mara Safari Camp is a luxury tented camp located on the edge of the Oloonkewuan hills in the Siana conservancy and on the eastern edge of the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve. It takes 20 minutes from the camp to reach the reserve's Sekenani gate. Olkeri Mara consists of 12 luxury tents 10 being standard accommodation tents and 2 deluxe tents.

The area around the camp teems with abundant species of animals and birds all year round. Being in a conservancy offers that added exclusive game viewing through either walking guided safaris or nature walks, night game drives or the regular safari drives in our custom made vehicles.

The months of July to October are perfect to watch the spectacular annual wildebeest migration crossing the Mara river into the Masai Mara from Tanzania's Serengeti Game Reserve.

Your day is designed to be as exciting or relaxing as you wish. There is a variety of activities from which to choose from - game drives, interpretive bush walks, Masai community visits, and sundowners, picnic lunches to river crossing, spectacular bush banquets, and so much more to ensure a gratifying safari of a lifetime. A well worth it and recommended activity in the Masai Mara National Reserve is the balloon safari.

Guided Game Drives

We offer unlimited mileage game drives with full day game drives at no extra charge in addition to the regular morning and afternoon game drives. Using custom build vehicles our multi lingual professional safari guides take you through a thrilling game and bird viewing experience to

remember. The early morning from 6 am to 9 am; the midmorning after breakfast and finally the late afternoon from 3.30 pm returning to camp at sunset. Or you can indulge in a full day guided game safari to the Mara River with a packed picnic breakfast and/or lunch.
