

Fig Tree Camp is situated along the Talek River on the northern border of Africa's most famous Game Reserve, the Masai Mara about 240 Kilometers from Nairobi. Narok is the closest town about a 2 hours drive and 110 Kilometers away.

The Masai Mara is home of the "Big Five" and the magical spectacle of the wildebeest migration.

Fig Tree Camp is situated on the northern border of the Masai Mara Game Reserve and its central location makes all areas of the Masai Mara National Reserve accessible during game drives. www.crocodileracers.com

Fig Tree Camp is 24 Kilometers from Kneeler Airstrip and 40 minutes drive away. To make an evening a real adventure, at the Fig Tree Camp one can choose to stay in a tent or a chalet, giving the best of both worlds. The rooms spaciouly line up along the Talek River, overlooking the plains of the Masai Mara Game Reserve.

Fig Tree Camp accommodation includes a total of 70 rooms which comprise of 38 Standard Safari Tents overlooking the Talek River, each with a double and single bed, 22 Garden Chalets with double and single beds and 10 Superior / Luxury Ngaboli Tents on the banks of the Talek River.

Fig Tree Ngaboli tents are the super luxury tents located on a private wing of the Camp with open views over the Mara Game Reserve All rooms are en-suite and have their private balcony.
